INTRODUCTION

Home Mission within the Baptist Union of Great Britain (BUGB) has its roots in the early 20th century, notably with the establishment of the Ministerial Settlement and Sustentation Scheme in 1912. This initiative aimed to provide financial support to smaller churches unable to fully fund a minister's stipend, thereby ensuring the sustainability of ministry across diverse communities. <u>baptist.org.uk</u>

Historically, Baptists have emphasized the importance of collective action in mission work. Individual churches recognized that collaborating through associations and societies was essential to effectively spread the Gospel. The formation of the Baptist Missionary Society in 1792 exemplifies this cooperative spirit, focusing on overseas mission. Similarly, the Baptist Home Missionary Society, established in 1797, concentrated on domestic evangelism, supporting itinerant preachers and strengthening local congregations.

Today, Home Mission remains vital for Baptists as it embodies the collective effort to support and sustain ministry across the UK. By pooling resources, Baptist churches can ensure that even congregations with limited financial means receive the necessary support to maintain their ministries. This collaborative approach not only upholds the principle of mutual aid but also enhances the overall mission potential of Baptist communities, enabling them to effectively share God's love within their local contexts.

HOME MISSION VIDEO

SERMON OUTLINE: STEWARDING OUR TIME, TITHES, AND TALENTS FOR MISSION

Key Scripture: 1 Peter 4:10 - "Use whatever gift you have received to serve others."

Introduction

• Start with a story or testimony about how generosity has transformed a church or mission project. *Home Mission stories can be found on <u>our website here</u>*

• Introduce Home Mission as a practical example of how collective giving supports national, regional, and local churches.

1. Stewarding Our Tithes 2 Corinthians 9:6-8.

- Giving is an act of worship.
- Home Mission's funding structure reflects biblical principles of shared generosity.
- Challenge: Are we giving faithfully to support God's work?

2. Stewarding Our Time: Using Our Days for Kingdom Work Ephesians 5:15-16

- Time is a gift from God—how are we using it?
- Home Mission supports local outreach are we engaging with our community?
- Ask: What can we do to serve God with our time?

3. Stewarding Our Talents - Serving Through Our Gifts 1 Peter 4:10-11

- We all have unique gifts.
- Challenge: How can our skills be used for mission—whether in church, community, or work?
- Home Mission funds pioneering ministries that use diverse talents for God's Kingdom.

4. The Impact of Collective Stewardship Acts 2:44-45

- The early church pooled their resources to serve God's mission.
- Home Mission is an example of modern-day Kingdom stewardship.
- Challenge: How can we, as a church, support mission through giving, serving, and sharing?

Conclusion & Call to Action

- Reinforce the importance of stewardship.
- Challenge the congregation to respond:
- Commit to regular giving (tithes & offerings).
- Dedicate time to serving.
- Use talents for ministry and mission.
- Ask: What is God calling you to give—your time, your resources, or your talents?

Closing Prayer: Ask God for wisdom in stewarding what He has given us.
